BYLAW #4-03 A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PORCUPINE PLAIN TO PERMIT OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES ON ROADWAYS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

The council of the Town of Porcupine Plain in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Under Section 9 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act, All Terrain Vehicles shall be permitted to operate within the Town of Porcupine Plain subject to the following conditions:
- a) All travel to be on back alleys except crossing of streets or avenue will be permitted.
- b) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin or destination within the Town of Porcupine Plain to or from the Town of Porcupine Plain corporate limits.
- 2) An operator who does not comply with the conditions set forth shall be guilty of an offence and subject to the penalties set forth in the All Terrain Vehicles Act and the Highway Traffic Act or any bylaw of the Town of Porcupine Plain regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 3) This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.
