BYLAW #10-02 A BYLAW TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATS AND DOGS

The council of the Town of Porcupine Plain in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Interpretation

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a)" dog and cat": shall mean either male or female over six (6) months old.

(b) "municipality" shall mean the Town of Porcupine Plain.

(c) "administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality.

(c) running at large" shall mean when the cat or dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not under control by being:

(i) in direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or

(ii) securely confined within an enclosure; or

(iii) securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.

License

2. (a) Every person within the municipality who owns, possesses, or harbours a cat or dog shall obtain a license from the Town of Porcupine Plain.

(b) The license shall be in effect from January 1 to December 31 of a calendar year and shall be obtained on or before March 31st of the said calendar year.

(c) The license fee shall be:

(i) for each dog

\$10

(ii) for each cat

\$10

- (d) The sum payable for a license required after July 1st shall be 50% of the charge for a full year.
- 3. Every person to whom a license has been issued under this bylaw shall cause his cat or dog to wear a collar to which shall be attached the license tag issued by the municipality pursuant to this bylaw.

Infraction of a Bylaw

- 4. A person residing in the municipality who owns, possesses, or harbours a cat or dog, and neglects or refuses to take out a license therefor shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
- 5. No cat or dog shall run at large in the municipality
- 6. A person who owns, possesses, or harbours a cat or dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
- 7. Any person may take any cat or dog found running at large contrary to the provisions of this bylaw to the municipal pound, where it shall be kept for three (3) days unless the owner, possessor, or harbourer redeems the cat or dog by paying the Town of Porcupine Plain the sum of:
 - (a) The applicable license fee (Sec. 2) plus a \$25 surcharge if animal is not licensed upon capture and;

(b)(i) First Offence

\$50

(b)(ii) Second Offence

\$75

(b)(iii) Subsequent Offences \$100


- 8. Any resident of the Town of Porcupine Plain except employees and elected officials of the Town of Porcupine Plain who apprehends any cat or dog running at large in the municipality and delivers same to the municipal pound shall be remunerated as follows:
 - (a) dog

\$50

(b) cat

\$5

- 9. (a) The Administrator may sell any cat or dog which is not redeemed within three (3) days.
 - (b) The Administrator, or at his request, any other person, may destroy any cat or dog which has not been redeemed within three (3) days.
- 10. (2) The Notice of Violation shall be in Form "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 11. Bylaws #2-83 and 9-84 are hereby repealed.
