**HOLIDAY TREE LIGHTING 2025**

On Thursday, November 27th, Johnston Agencies hosted the 12th Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony. In a surprising twist from tradition, temperatures hovered around a balmy -10°C instead of the usual -25°C deep freeze we've come to expect!

Sharing the evening with Late Night Shopping, Bob Nicholson, long-standing Master of Ceremonies, encouraged everyone to support the businesses that support our community year-round, noting, "I don't recall ever getting anything from Amazon or Walmart when it comes to donations."

Bob carried on his tradition of delightfully corny dad jokes, but this year arrived with something extra: his Roughrider jersey and a story of heroic holiday determination. He launched into his Grey Cup tale — a quest to ask Santa for a Riders win. What started as a simple wish turned into an adventure in Winnipeg. Santa on site, a long lineup, kids everywhere, Bomber fans blocking the path... and Bob's inner A.J. Ouellette emerging as he powered through for his moment with Santa. And wouldn't you know it — the Riders won the Grey Cup. Bob happily concluded that Santa must be a Rider fan too!

With the crowd fully warmed up (and not just from the fire), Bob outlined the qualities needed to earn the title of Official Tree Lighter: someone community-minded, who carries the Christmas spirit of kindness all year. Amber Stadnek and Mary Ryhorski then came forward to introduce this year's honourees: the Caring Hearts of the Red Deer Nursing Home (RDNH). This dedicated group has made it their mission to brighten the lives of RDNH residents — creating a warm, home-like environment both inside and outside the facility. Through countless hours of volunteering and fundraising, they repainted spaces, added plants and décor, and completed a major renovation of the outdoor sitting area.

Residents and families deeply appreciate their efforts, which truly go above and beyond. As Amber shared, "Thank you, Caring Hearts, for taking care of the people who once took care of us." With smiles all around, the Caring Hearts team gave the official command to "Light that Tree!"

Amber Hoffus of Johnston Agencies, event sponsor, then expressed thanks to those who made the night possible and shared how meaningful the Caring Hearts team's work has been for her own grandmother in the Nursing Home. She reflected on

a conversation they had years ago — that the things on our wish lists fade quickly, but the memories we make with loved ones last forever. Amber closed with a message for all of us: "Make memories, not perfection — because that's what really matters."

The bonfire crackled, cookies and cocoa were enjoyed, families cuddled together on a sparkle-tour wagon ride through town, and the community made new memories to carry into the season.

A heartfelt thank you to everyone who contributed to the success of the night: The Porcupine Volunteer Fire Department for tending the fire; the Sr. Boys Basketball Team for setup and takedown; Craig Kriger for stringing the tree lights; Bob, Amber, and Mary for their words; the entire Johnston Agencies team for organizing; and Hoffus Stock Farms for jumping in last-minute with a tractor and wagon. And finally, thank you to everyone who came out to celebrate the season and honour this year's Official Tree Lighters. It was a warm night in more ways than one.
